It is extremely important that this creates opportunities for exports to the European countries. The core purpose of seminar was to provide awareness among progressive farmers, faculty. Organic farming has potential in

Pakistan and an environmentally sustainable way of crop production with good management and cultural practices. There is need for training and awareness on best performance irrigation system, supply chain, marketing and prevailing organic farming techniques are being imparted to the farmers. Awareness and sensitization have to be created to reduce the use of chemical fertilizers and pesticides. He further said that at least progressive farmers can grow organic vegetables and fruits on their farms as a model for themselves, which will spread awareness about organic farming in the area. It will be possible to get safe and healthy food for our future generations.

Senior Scientist Dr. Daniel Bernhard Neuhoff while addressing the seminar said that Pakistan need National Organic Agriculture Program, Laws, Regulations, Framework, Labeling and Certification body and we are ready for collaboration with key stakeholders. During the visit to Pakistan and after holding meetings in various institutions. It has been estimated that organic farming has immense potential in this country. Along with conventional farming, organic farming should develop as a component of agriculture in Pakistan. Dr. Daniel Bernhard Neuhoff also answered the farmers' questions.

On this occasion Prof. Dr. Saleem Farooq Shaukat, Director CUI-Vehari thanked the guests. The shields were presented to the guests and seminar organizer and certificates to the students. On this occasion, the German delegation conducted an interactive session with the farmers.
